locate to the new center council meetings and municipal court proceedings.

The largest component of the general fund budget is the street department at almost \$493,000, followed by the police department with total anticipated expenditures of almost \$483,000. Of that total, almost \$368,000 is for personnel.

City administration figures were budgeted at almost \$379,000. Of that total, almost \$159,000 will go to payroll and associated expenses.

Other general fund budget totals include \$33,750 for the fire department; \$17,600 for municipal court; and more than \$186,000 for the tourism fund.

Aldermen also got a look at the proposed 2009 budget for the water and sewer department showing total revenues of \$655,000, down slightly from the 2008 budget of \$660,500. Total expenditures were put at approximately \$633,000.

The council also approved an interlocal agreement with the county for the repair and maintenance of the parking lot behind the courthouse.

Acting on the advice of City Administrator Jim Gibson and Police Chief Gary Amburn, aldermen voted to begin the task of placing more than 60 stop signs at various locations around town.
